

From The Pastor's Desk.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"What are you giving up for Lent?" For centuries this has been a popular question as we approach the 40 day season of Lent, which begins this year on March 1 with Ash Wednesday. Jesus fasted from food and drink for 40 days in the wilderness as he prepared to begin his public ministry, completely emptying himself. During these 40 days we empty ourselves by choosing to go without something that is a regular part of our lives: giving up chocolate, or desserts, or smoking; or giving up some of our free time to devote to bible study and prayer.

During Wednesdays in Lent this year, we will challenge ourselves to a different kind of fast. Following the book A World Worth Saving by George Donigan, we will give up the deadly attitude of apathy that so regularly pervades our lives. Instead of focusing on our own self-



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improvement, we will focus on improving the lives of others. We will empty ourselves of narrow self-concern and open ourselves to the deep, compassionate love of God. As we connect more deeply to God's love, the Holy Spirit will move us from prayer to action. In fact, our prayer will take the form of action for the sake of others, motivated by love.



During Sundays in Lent, and for our daily devotional reading throughout the season, we will join hundreds of other ELCA congregations by focusing on Martin Luther's Small Catechism in this 500th Anniversary Year of the Protestant

Reformation. My sermon each Sunday in Lent will look at of the five major sections of the Catechism: one Commandments, Apostles Creed, Lord's Prayer, Ten Holy Baptism and Holy Communion. Our devotional book is Free Indeed! from Augsburg-Fortress.

I look forward to what will be my first Lenten journey with you, and am excited about where the Holy Spirit will lead us! Yours in the Love of Christ.

WORSHIP SCHEDULE SURVEY

Last fall, we surveyed the congregation concerning a possible change to our Sunday morning schedule for worship and Sunday School. Of the four options given, two received the most support and were roughly equal in the level of support. One was to keep the schedule as is; the other was to return to a schedule similar to what Immanuel had used for many years before the schedule was changed about 7 years ago, with an early service around 8:30am, Sunday School around 9:45am and late service around 11am. Precise times would be worked out.

The primary reason for moving to the one service was our difficulty sustaining two services with enough volunteers to fill the necessary positions. If we want to consider going back to two services, we would first need firm volunteer commitments from enough people for each of the two worship hours. The decision for now is to continue our current worship and Sunday School schedule, working to build up the congregation and our volunteer base toward the day when we may be ready to add a second service. Please contact the church office or Susan Burnette if you would like to volunteer as a worship assistant (communion server, altar guild, reader, usher, greeter, choir member) at the existing service and/or a future late service.

Soup/Study at noon or 6pm at Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church. Worship with Disposition of Ashes and Communion at 1pm or 7pm.

Our worship will include the option of walking a labyrinth. The labyrinth dates back 5,000 years or more. Beginning in the Middle Ages, Christianity adopted the labyrinth as a symbol, changing the design to imbue it with specifically Christian meaning. For almost a thousand years there has been an identifiable Christian labyrinth tradition.

Our labyrinth will be built from food cans which will later be donated to NESAP and Tree of Friends foodbanks.



Your church council met Tuesday, February 14, 2017 in the Martin Luther room. The following business was discussed and acted upon.

NEW BUSINESS

There was an unauthorized entrance into Immanuel church at 4:15am. Investigation by the sheriff's department and the church sexton proved nothing was stolen and nothing was damaged. This has prompted church council to approve ^{\$7500.00} to secure our property. Hardware will be updated, keypads will be added and the church will be completely rekeyed.

Lenten activities were discussed and planned. Information is provided in this publication regarding the numerous opportunities to worship at Immanuel and Trinity UCC during the Lenten season. Check the Fellowship and Worship and Music reports.

OLD BUSINESS

The registration for Mar Lu Ridge is complete. Twenty children will be attending camp this summer. Thank you to the generous Immanuel member for sponsoring these children.

Stewardship Sunday was celebrated at Immanuel the weekend of February 18 and 19. A 2017 Estimate of Giving card is enclosed in this newsletter. You are encouraged to complete this card and return it to Immanuel if you did not attend on Stewardship Sunday. A full Stewardship campaign will be conducted in the fall pointing toward 2018 giving of time, talents and treasure.

The Finance committee and Pastor Charlie will reach out to members of the congregation who have loved one's memorial funds pending use.

Text/App giving was discussed. Eight members now use online giving on a recurring basis. Fifteen families give online sporadically. Giving via text message and mobile app will provide additional ways for members and visitors to give to God through Immanuel. 
