TODAY, May 15, Immanuel celebrates the Festival of Pentecost. On the fiftieth day of Easter, we celebrate the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is a day of promises fulfilled. The promised Spirit of God is poured out upon each one of us. The baptized become "the children of God" and "the joint heirs with Christ."
